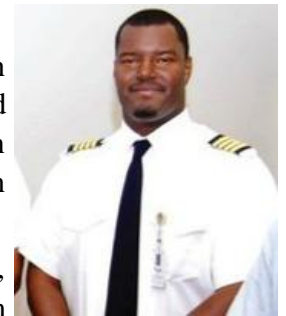

## PAST ST. IGNATIUS STUDENTS ... WHERE ARE THEY NOW???

Brian Seales attended St. Ignatius and graduated with the Class of 2000. He joined Cayman Airways that year, and worked on the ticket counter until 2004. From 2004-2007 he attended the Florida Institute of Technology, graduating with a Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.), Aviation Management with Flight Option. While attending FIT, Brian continued to work for Cayman Airways during summer and Christmas breaks.



After earning his degree at FIT, Brian worked as a First Officer for Cayman Airways Express, piloting the Twin Otters on the Grand Cayman-Cayman Brac-Little Cayman routes from May 2007 through October 2009. In October 2009, he was promoted to Captain at Cayman Airway Express and continued to fly to the Sister Islands. In July 2013 he achieved his dream of moving to the jets, becoming a First Officer on the Boeing 737-300 aircraft. Since then, Brian flies much further in his piloting duties for Cayman Airways, heading to such destinations as New York, Chicago, Dallas, Tampa, Miami and Panama.

When not on duty Brian enjoys spending time with family and friends.
