In addition, the following rules must be adhered to:

- Shirts and blouses must be tucked in at all times and the sleeves rolled down
- Trousers must be worn so that the belt is around the waist
- Trousers must not be bunched or split at the bottom
- Boy's hair must be tidy, collar length or shorter and not touching the eyes with neutral or natural colours only
- Boy's may have a tidy moustache, beard or goatee
- Girl's hair may be worn loose but must be tied up when Health and Safety rules apply and must be of neutral or natural colours.
- Hairpins and bobbles of any colour are permitted but bandanas must not be worn
- A slim, religious chain and a class ring are permitted but bracelets and wristbands must not be worn
- For girls, one small pair of stud or small hoop earrings and light makeup, clear nail varnish and lip balm are permitted.
- Visible body piercing, including nose rings or tattooing, are not permitted
