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We invite applications from fully qualified and suitably experienced Teachers for the following positions to start **August 2023**.

All candidates are expected to:

- Have a recognised and relevant degree in the subject from an accredited university, and a PGCE, QTS or other internationally recognised teaching qualification.
- Evidence of leading/coordinating any subject-related curricular and extra-curricular initiatives and activities would be an advantage.
- Experience in teaching an additional subject is preferred, therefore applicants should include this information within the application. The teaching of A level Psychology as an additional subject would be a distinct advantage.
- Be committed to Christ-centered values and beliefs.
- Model excellent practice in the classroom; preferably externally verified.
- Have a secure knowledge and understanding of excellent practice in teaching, learning, and the effective use of assessment to improve learning and use data effectively.
- Be able to demonstrate the impact of teaching on the progress of individual groups and cohorts of children.
- Be committed to continuing professional development.
- Be proficient in using modern educational information technology systems.
- Have excellent knowledge of Safeguarding and Child Protection good practices with recent, relevant training.
- Be an excellent team player committed to the Catholic ethos, values and aims of the school, and be committed to the holistic education of children.

Candidates are also expected to have the following subject specific skills and experience:

**Teacher of Science (preferably with a Chemistry and/or Physics specialism)**

- At least three years of experience teaching Science across Key Stages 3 – 5 with evidence of successful examination results at I/GCSE and A Level in recent years.
- Familiarity and experience with the Cambridge International examination board and an ability to teach some Key Stage 2 Science (if required) would be a distinct advantage.

**Teacher of Travel and Tourism and Business Studies**

- At least three to five years of experience teaching Travel and Tourism and Business Studies across Key Stages 4 – 5 with evidence of successful examination results at I/GCSE and A Level in recent years. Familiarity and experience in preparing and moderating coursework for Travel and Tourism and teaching the Cambridge International examination board syllabus in each subject would be a distinct advantage.

**Duties will include, but will not be limited to:**

- To provide pastoral, academic and behavioural support for children per school policies and procedures.
- To keep good records of the progress of the children in the class/group and to be able to use the formal assessment processes of the school, both for formative and summative purposes.
- To support parents with referrals to outside agencies, where required.
- To meet with parents, staff and children to provide support with Individual Education Planning and Learning plan support, where required.
- To provide communication to parents, including formal reports and meetings with parents regarding their child's progress.
- Lead and/or be involved in a wide range of school-related extra-curricular activities.
