Teaching Assistant

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Working in partnership with the teacher with individuals or classes in activities such as, but not exclusive to:
 - EYFS and child-initiated learning.
 - Phonics/Reading interventions and assessments.
 - Key Stage 1 or 2 Standardised Assessments Testing.
 - Children who have SEND or are not making the expected levels of progress.
 - Interventions, Benchmarking and assisting in the preparation and distribution of programme aids and materials.
- Demonstrating progress of pupils with whom they work in conjunction with the teacher and reinforce educational concepts to individuals/classes using instructional objectives and lessons developed by the teacher.
- Supervising the After-School Care Programme two afternoons each week and be involved in extra-curricular.

Qualifications, experience, and skills required:

- At a minimum, a recognised Teaching Assistants qualification, however, preference will be given to candidates who possess a Bachelor of Education degree or equivalent from an accredited university, and a PGCE, QTS or other internationally recognised teaching qualification. This is necessary to allow successful candidates to provide much needed cover for class teachers.
- A minimum of three years' recent working experience in a primary school in supporting learning and development.
- Must have good knowledge, understanding and experience of the UK curriculum and its requirements.
- Must be able to demonstrate impact on children's learning.
- Must be excellent classroom practitioners, passionate about students' learning.
- Must have a secure understanding of behaviour management of students.
- Must have an excellent knowledge of Safeguarding and Child Protection good practice with recent, relevant training.
- Have excellent emotional intelligence and an ability to be flexible.
- Be an excellent team player committed to the Catholic ethos, values and aims of the school, and be committed to the holistic education of the child.

Salary ranges: CI\$26,010.00 - CI\$34,333.00 per annum commensurate with qualifications and experience based on the school's salary scales, plus one free school place for the child of an employee. Other benefits include medical insurance and contribution to a pension plan.
