Reporting to the Vice Principal of Primary, the Teaching and Learning Lead (TLL) is responsible for the ongoing improvement of teaching and learning in the school, ensuring increasing consistency of outstanding practice, particularly in the primary school. The TLL plays a key role in the leadership of the school.

The main scope of this role is to ensure that teaching across the primary leads to more consistent outstanding student progress and learning skills development. The TLL will be expected to accurately evaluate the quality of teaching on an ongoing basis, and work alongside teachers through effective targeted and differentiated initiatives. - Bachelor's degree, teacher training such as PGCE and Qualified Teacher Status or equivalent. Master's degree in teaching or equivalent is desirable.
- A minimum of six years' teaching experience.
- A minimum of three years' experience in a leadership position, with a track record of improving practice in the primary, ideally in an outstanding school that follows the English National Curriculum.
- Confidence in the interpretation and use of student data.
- Experience working with international students and families with a deep, working knowledge of the importance of culturally responsive practice.
- Child protection checks and safer recruitment practices will be undertaken.
