This role is pivotal in supporting students and ensure their academic, extracurricular, personal and social development and entitlement. The WSIL acts as a student liaison and advocate, linking to all relevant departments and stakeholders to ensure student success. The WSIL plays a key role in the leadership of the school. Candidates should have the following qualifications and skills:

- Bachelor's degree, teacher training such as PGCE and Qualified Teacher Status or equivalent. Master's degree in inclusion or equivalent is preferable.
- A minimum of six years' teaching experience.
- A minimum of three years' experience in a leadership position, with a track record of improving the provision for inclusion in schools, ideally across all year groups.
- Confidence in the use and interpretation of student data.
- Relevant experience in the administration, interpretation and reporting on psychoeducational assessments.
- Experience working with international students and families with a deep, working knowledge of the importance of culturally responsive practice.
- Child protection checks and safer recruitment practices will be undertaken.
