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St. Ignatius Catholic School is a private co-educational school with approximately 665 pupils ranging from Nursery to Advanced Level. The school is recognised for its academic rigour, its excellent discipline and its caring and supportive Christian ethos. It follows the English National Curriculum to I/GCSE with many students progressing to our A-Level programme.

We invite applications from fully qualified and suitably experienced teachers for the following positions for **August 2019**.

All candidates are expected to:

- Have a recognised degree in their subject area or a Bachelor of Education from an accredited university, and a PGCE, QTS or other internationally recognised teaching qualification.
- Have experience in teaching the UK National Curriculum at Key Stages 3 – 5, as well as CIE/WJEC syllabus up to A Level, where required.
- Be committed to Christ-centered values and beliefs.
- Model excellent practice in the classroom (preferably externally verified).
- Have a secure knowledge and understanding of excellent practice in teaching, learning and the effective use of assessment to improve learning, and be able to use data effectively.
- Be able to demonstrate impact of teaching on the progress of individual groups and cohorts of children.
- Be committed to continued professional development.
- Be proficient in using Microsoft Office/Office 365 products. Experience with SIMS would be an advantage.
- Have an excellent knowledge of Safeguarding and Child Protection good practice with recent, relevant training.
- Be an excellent team player committed to the ethos, values and aims of the school.
- Be committed to the holistic education of the child.
- Lead and/or be involved in a wide range of school related extra-curricular activities.

In addition to these qualifications, candidates are also expected to have the following skills/experience as outlined below:

Teacher/Subject Leader: Art

- 5 years of experience in teaching Art and Design across Key Stages 3 – 5, with evidence of successful examination results at I/GCSE and A Level in recent years.
- An informed vision for the development of the subject in terms of improving teaching, learning and the use of assessment, curriculum development and raising standards of academic achievement across all key stages.
- Preferably at least 3 years of experience in leading an Art department.
- Evidence of a commitment to fully support the extra-curricular programme as a means of enhancing the Art curriculum.
- Engage students in the external competitions and exhibitions to raise the profile of Art within the school and the local community.

Teacher of Physical Education

- Experience in teaching Primary and Secondary Physical Education.
- A working knowledge and understanding of UK National Curriculum PE in Key Stages 2-3.
- Can demonstrate experience with and a commitment to teaching a range of extra-curricular sports activities.
- Shows evidence of recent/up-to-date sports coaching/officiating qualifications.
- Experience of some Primary classroom teaching would be an advantage.
- Some experience in teaching I/GCSE and A Level Physical Education is not essential but would be an advantage.

Teacher of Mathematics

- 3 - 5 years of experience in teaching Mathematics across Key Stages 3 – 5, with evidence of successful examination results at I/GCSE and A Level in recent years.
- Candidates should specify particular area of strength/experience in teaching A Level Mathematics, however experience in teaching the CIE A level Mechanics syllabus would be an advantage.

Teacher of Physics and Mathematics

- 3 - 5 years of experience in teaching Physics across Key Stages 3 – 5, with evidence of successful examination results at I/GCSE and A Level.
- Recent experience in teaching Mathematics at Key Stages 3 and 4 would be a distinct advantage.

Teacher of French & Spanish

- 3 - 5 years of experience teaching both French and Spanish ideally to A Level or at least one subject to A Level and the other to GCSE Level.
- Evidence of successful examination results at I/GCSE and A Level in recent years.
- Experience at KS3 in both languages is needed however any Primary experience would be advantageous.

Salary range CI\$42,548 - CI\$56,000 per annum, depending on qualifications and experience.

Science Lab Technician (Full time)

Candidates are expected to:

- Have a Science degree and a minimum of 2 - 3 years' current experience as a high school science lab technician.
- Preference will be given to applicants who possess a science/lab technician certification/qualification, safety certifications in handling and storing chemicals, and first-aid.
- Be familiar and experienced with I/GCSE and A-Level examination specifications in Biology, Chemistry and Physics in order to prepare and assist with practical examinations and coursework.

Salary range: CI\$30,000.00 to CI\$40,000.00 per annum, depending on qualifications and experience.

Other benefits for all positions include medical insurance, contribution to a pension plan., and one free school place for the child of an employee.

As a Catholic school, we strongly encourage committed Catholics to apply but we also welcome applications from non-Catholics. However, we expect all applicants to fully support the religious ethos of the school.
